

SCHOLARSHIPS 4 Us®



"Scholarships 4 Us[®] is the Legislative-Compliance enterprise for potential collegiate athletes and students. We provide students a national standardized platform to accumulate Prize Funds funded with Prize Money in our Accredited Events and Exclusive Rights of Use for youth organizations to manage the events. When an eligible student enrolls in The Scholarships 4 Us[®] Program the student establishes what is known as their ESA or Earning and Savings Account that is assigned to an Enrollment ID.

In every event, Student-Participants will accrue savings and have the opportunity to accumulate Prize Funds funded with Prize Money based on Place Finish. The Prize Funds funded with Prize Money shall be managed within The Trust of Scholarships 4 Us[®] which is managed using the S4Us.portal[™].

Scholarships 4 Us[®] is *not* a nonprofit scholarship organization that manages and disburses donor and sponsor taxdeductible contributions. We are a for-profit third-party enterprise that manages Prize Funds funded with Prize Money under Scholarships 4 Us[®]: The 5 Principles of Amateurism[™] with the intended purpose for the funds to be disbursed as a Scholarship Award. Former Student-Participants are entitled to request their accumulated Prize Funds funded with Prize Money as either Prize Money (taxable income) or a Scholarship Award (non-taxable income).

Usage of The Scholarships 4 Us[®] Program protects potential collegiate athletes' eligibility standards set forth by the NCAA[®], NAIA[®], NJCAA[®], and NACE[®]. Scholarships 4 Us[®] has no affiliation with the NCAA[®], NAIA[®], NJCAA[®], NACE[®], or postsecondary educational institutions but may provide records regarding Student-Participants' enrollment, participation, and disbursement request to ensure our commitment to being the Legislative-Compliance enterprise for potential collegiate athletes and students."

THE NJCAA® BYLAWS STATE THAT NO POTENTIAL STUDENT-ATHLETE CAN ACCEPT PRIZE MONEY AFTER THAT NO POTENTIAL STUDENT-ATHLETE CAN ACCEPT PRIZE MONEY AFTER THEIR 19TH BIRTHDAY OR ENROLLED IN A NJCAA® INSTITUTION- WHICHEVER ONE COMES FIRST.

Scholarships 4 Us[®] was founded to fund The Scholarship System 4 Us through secondary educational institutions and youth organizations that specialize in The Arts, Sports, or Esports, registering as an Accredited Hosts[™] and managing Accredited Events.

- The Cost of Entry in an Accredited Event[™] is either \$40, \$80, or \$160.
- All Accredited Events will be described on the Scholarships 4 Us[®] website under the Events Tab and corresponding subcategory: The Arts, Sports, or Esports.
- The Cost of Entry is itemized as followed:

SCHOLARSHIPS 4 Us®

- 25%: Savings Contribution
- 25%: Expense and Lineage

*The Expense is the Fee for Accredited Hosts™, and the Lineage is the fee for the Scholarships 4 Us®

- 50%: Prize Fund
- An Accredited Event is managed by a registered youth organization recognized as an Accredited Hosts™ which will be assigned to a Hosts ID through the S4Us.portal™.
- ◆ An Accredited Hosts[™] may request to use the trust as a service to manage their own Accredited Events.
- ◆ Eligible students will enroll in The Scholarships 4 Us[®] Program through the S4Us.portal[™] and be provided an (ESA) Earnings and Savings Account assigned to an Enrollment ID.
- ◆ An enrolled student will be recognized as a Student-Participant that competes in an Accredited Event™.
- Student-Participants will accrue savings in every event they participate in and have the opportunity to accumulate Prize Funds funded with Prize Money based on Place Finish.







- ◆ Accredited Hosts[™] and Student-Participants will use the Scholarships 4 Us[®] Accredited Events Guide to determine the Cost of Entry in an Accredited Event[™].
- An Accredited Event[™] will use the Allocation of Itemized Prize Funds found in the Scholarships 4 Us[®] Accredited Events Guide.
- An Accredited Hosts[™] will use the Create An Event Form in the S4Us.portal[™] for Student-Participants to sign-up and check-in for the Accredited Event[™].
- Accredited Hosts™ will collect their Lineage Fee at the Accredited Event™ while the Savings Contribution, Expense, and Prize Fund will be submitted to Scholarships 4 Us[®] through the S4Us.portal™ at sign-up.
- ◆ After completion of the Accredited Event[™] the Accredited Hosts[™] will submit the Close An Event Form with Place Finish using the Student-Participants' Enrollment ID through the S4Us.portal[™].
- Prize Funds and Savings Contributions will be managed in Trust of Scholarships 4 Us[®].
- ◆ The Trust of Scholarships 4 Us[®] Service Agreement shall be signed by all Student-Participants and Accredited Hosts[™].
- ◆ Scholarships 4 Us[®] shall recognize The 5 Principles of Amateurism[™] as our Purpose of Formation.
- A Student-Participant may forfeit their accumulated Prize Funds if it determined that they have intentionally failed to disclose they withdrew from The Rule of Amateurism.
- Third-party funding to increase the Prize Funds and Savings Contributions are forbidden in an Accredited Event[™] and an Accredited Hosts[™] determined to have initiated or was aware and failed to prevent such transaction will have a revocation of their accreditation.







- The Scholarships 4 Us[®] Program is designed for primary educational institutions to receive a percentage of the Lineage revenue earned by secondary educational institutions within their district, tax-free, so long as the funds are used according to IRS Topic No. 421.
- Scholarships 4 Us[®] may also determine a limited number of neutral organizations, and a system of allocation, where individuals and businesses can contribute funding directly for Student-Participants' Cost of Entry in an Accredited Event[™].

No longer will every student in America have a 97% chance of NOT being selected as a recipient of the 1.7 million scholarships awarded each year or a 98% chance of NOT being offered an Athletic Scholarship. A Scholarship, since the first one was awarded almost 400 years ago, was never an actual '*thing*,' it is 'non-taxable income.' America will become united in The Scholarship System 4 Us by ensuring that all students are enrolled in The Scholarships 4 Us[®] Program for as long as it is useful for our kind.



The collegiate athletic associations write legislation that determines the eligibility criterion for athletes to compete in their competitions or tournament including accepting Prize Money based on Place Finish. Scholarships 4 Us® ensures potential collegiate athletes maintains compliant by managing Prize Money and disbursing the funds directly to the postsecondary educational institution as a Scholarship Award.

THE PROGRAM

<u>IRS</u>

SCHOLARSHIPS 4 Us®

The IRS topic no. 421 scholarships, fellowship grants, and other grants recognizes these award earnings as tax-free so as long the "amount is used to pay for tuition and fees required for enrollment or attendance at the educational institution, or for fees, books, supplies, and equipment required for courses at the educational institution." Any other usage of the awards for "incidental expenses, such as room and board, travel or optional equipment must be reported as gross income.

<u>NCAA</u>®

The NCAA® permits potential collegiate students-athletes to earn prize money based on place finish in events so long as the amount does not exceed actual and necessary expenses to participate. The NCAA® requires all potential collegiate studentathletes to complete their Eligibility Questionnaire to determine if amateurism status has been maintained by requesting documentation of sports participation and any accepted prize money. These records are to be kept by the student-athlete and any misinformation or falsification could lead to a determination resulting in a permanent ineligibility status.

<u>NAIA</u>®

Potential collegiate student-athletes must complete their Eligibility Questionnaire and the bylaws state that no potential collegiate student-athlete can accept prize money after July 31st, the 'last day of summer,' prior to enrolling into an NAIA[®] institution. These records are to be kept by the student-athlete and any misinformation or falsification could lead to a determination resulting in a permanent ineligibility status.







<u>NJCAA</u>®

Potential collegiate student-athletes must complete their Amateurism Questionnaire and the bylaws state that no potential collegiate student-athlete can accept prize money after their 19th birthday or once enrolled in an NJCAA® institution-whichever comes first. These records are to be kept by the student-athlete and any misinformation or falsification could lead to a determination resulting in a permanent ineligibility status.

<u>NACE</u>®

Potential collegiate student-athletes must complete their Eligibility Certificate Form, and the bylaws do not state legislation governing student-athletes accepting prize money.

POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS

Postsecondary educational institutions require all students to report private awarded scholarships to the Financial Aid Department as it may adjust their Financial Aid Award.





THE PROGRAM

Scholarships 4 Us[®] requires youth organizations to register as an Accredited Hosts[™] for exclusive rights to use The Scholarships 4 Us[®] Program and platforms. The Registration Requirements and procedure is designed to ensure current and future Students-Participants will have a trusted source committed to providing Accredited Events.

THE PROGRAM

Condition Statement

SCHOLARSHIPS 4 Us®

Youth Organizations are required to provide Articles of Incorporation/Organization, and General Liability Insurance at the time of registration. Scholarships 4 Us[®] is not liable for sustained injuries to participants or attendees of Accredited Events managed by an Accredited Hosts[™] and any misconduct or negligence by the business or venue owner(s) and personnel associated 'with' or 'within' the organization(s). Students will sign the 'Student-Participant Waiver' at the time of enrollment that will require a parent, legal guardian, or authorized representative's consent if they are a minor.

<u>Terms</u>




