In every event Student-Participants will accrue savings and have the opportunity to accumulate prize funds if they place top five in our accredited events.

Scholarships 4 Us® is not a scholarship provider, we manage prize funds as a third-party enterprise under The Rule of Amateurism™ with the intended purpose for the funds to be disbursed as a scholarship award.

Usage of The Scholarships 4 Us® Program protects potential collegiate athletes' eligibility standards set forth by the NCAA®, NAIA®, NJCAA®, NACE® and postsecondary educational institutions. Scholarships 4 Us® has no affiliation with the NCAA®, NAIA®, NJCAA®, NACE®, or postsecondary educational institutions. Scholarships 4 Us® maintains and provides records regarding Student-Participants enrollment, participation, and prize earnings upon request to ensure our commitment to being the Legislative-Compliance enterprise."

SECTION 3: INTRODUCTION

Scholarships 4 Us® was founded to fund our scholarship system through secondary educational institutions and youth organizations that specialize in the Arts, Sports, or Esports, registering as an Accredited Hosts and managing Accredited Events. An Accredited Event is a tournament or competition that awards prize funds based on place finish with the intended purpose for the funds to be disbursed as a scholarship award. The money spent on these after school youth sports and activities is the source of funding for our scholarship system.

- ◆ The Cost of Entry in an Accredited Event is either \$40, \$80, or \$160
- The Cost of Entry is divided into three categories:
 - -25%: Savings Contribution
 - -25%: Event Cost (Expense and Lineage)

The Expense is the fee for the Accredited Hosts and the Lineage is the fee for Scholarships 4 Us®

- -50%: Prize Funds
- Every event will have 25 entrants with a max of 25 participants per team and will be governed according to the Scholarships 4 Us[®]
 Accredited Events Guide
- Top 5 place finishes will accumulate Prize Funds based on the following percentages of the total Prize Funds collected:
 - 1st- 40%
 - 2nd- 24%
 - 3rd- 20%
 - 4th 8%
 - 5th- 8%
- A student is eligible to enroll in The Scholarships 4 Us® Program on their 12th birthday with an expiration of eligibility on May 31st the year of high school graduation.
- Each student that enrolls will be provided an ESA (Earning and Savings Account) assigned to an Enrollment ID in the Scholarships 4 Us® Portal. Prize Funds and Savings Contributions will be managed through Scholarships 4 Us®.





SECTION 3: continued

- Student-Participants will accrue savings in every event they participate in and have the opportunity to accumulate Prize Funds if they place top 5 in our Accredited Events.
- ◆ Scholarships 4 Us® will recognize The Rule of Amateurism™ as our Purpose of Formation so that Student-Participants are forbidden to ACCEPT prize money or receive any remuneration in our Accredited Events and will be expelled from The Program™ if it is determined that this purpose has not been fulfilled. A Student-Participant may forfeit their accumulated prize funds if it determined that they have intentionally failed to disclose they withdrew their Amateurism according to The Scholarships 4 Us® Program Section 9: Page 16.
- Third-party funding to increase the Prize Funds and Savings Contributions are forbidden in an Accredited Event and an Accredited Hosts determined to have initiated or was aware and failed to prevent such transaction will have a revocation of their accreditation.
- ♦ The Scholarships 4 Us® Program is designed for primary educational institutions to receive a percentage of the Lineage revenue earned by secondary educational institutions within their district, tax-free, so long as the funds are used according to IRS Topic No. 421
- Scholarships 4 Us® may also determine a limited number of neutral foundation(s), and a system of allocation, that can provide tax-deductions for donors and sponsors so that their funds may be used to directly fund Student-Participants' Cost of Entry in an Accredited Event.

No longer will every student in America have a 97% chance of NOT being selected as a recipient of the 1.7 million scholarships awarded each year or a 98% chance of NOT being offered an athletic scholarship. A scholarship since the first one was awarded almost 400 years ago was never an actual 'thing,' it is 'non-taxable income.' America will be united in the solution to student loan debt by ensuring that all students are enrolled in The Scholarships 4 Us® Program for as long as The Program™ is useful for our kind.







SECTION 4: LEGISLATIVE-COMPLIANCE

The Scholarships 4 Us® Program is formed to be compliant with the governing bylaws of the collegiate athletic associations and the legislation of the IRS. Scholarships 4 Us® annually reviews and updates The Program™ according to any changes regarding disbursing prize funds as a scholarship award.

<u>IRS</u>

The IRS topic no. 421 scholarships, fellowship grants, and other grants recognizes these award earnings as tax-free so as long the "amount is used to pay for tuition and fees required for enrollment or attendance at the educational institution, or for fees, books, supplies, and equipment required for courses at the educational institution." Any other usage of the awards for "incidental expenses, such as room and board, travel or optional equipment must be reported as gross income.

NCAA®

The NCAA® permits potential collegiate students-athletes to earn prize money based on place finish in events so long as the amount does not exceed actual and necessary expenses to participate. The NCAA® requires all potential collegiate student-athletes to complete their Eligibility Questionnaire to determine if amateurism status has been maintained by requesting documentation of sports participation and any accepted prize money. These records are to be kept by the student-athlete and any misinformation or falsification could lead to a determination resulting in a permanent ineligibility status.

NAIA®

Potential collegiate student-athletes must complete their Eligibility Questionnaire and the bylaws state that no potential collegiate student-athlete can accept prize money after July 31st, the 'last day of summer,' prior to enrolling into an NAIA® institution. These records are to be kept by the student-athlete and any misinformation or falsification could lead to a determination resulting in a permanent ineligibility status.

NJCAA®

Potential collegiate student-athletes must complete their Amateurism Questionnaire and the bylaws state that no potential collegiate student-athlete can accept prize money after their 19th birthday or once enrolled in an NJCAA® institution- whichever comes first. These records are to be kept by the student-athlete and any misinformation or falsification could lead to a determination resulting in a permanent ineligibility status.

NACE®

Potential collegiate student-athletes must complete their Eligibility Certificate Form and the bylaws do not state legislation governing student-athletes accepting prize money.

POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS

Postsecondary educational institutions require all students to report private awarded scholarships to the Financial Aid Department as it may adjust their Financial Aid Award.





SECTION 5: ACCREDITATION

Scholarships 4 Us® requires youth organizations to register as an Accredited Hosts for Exclusive Rights to use The Program™ and Platforms. The accreditation requirements and procedure is designed to ensure current and future Students-Participants will have a trusted source committed to providing Accredited Events.

Scholarships 4 Us[®] is not liable for sustained injuries to participants or attendees of Accredited Events and any misconduct or negligence by the business or venue owner(s) and personnel associated 'with' or 'within' the organization(s).

Terms

- 1. The top priority is to protect the health, safety and well-being of all Student-Participants, families, friends, and spectators
- 2. Scholarships 4 Us® has zero tolerance for sexual and other abuse or willful misconduct that jeopardizes the health, safety and well-being of Student-Participants, families, friends, or spectators
- 3. Any willful action, publicly or privately, that constitutes bigotry, discrimination, hate, physical violence, politicization, or any other action determined by the ownership company determinantal to The Scholarships 4 Us® Program shall be subject to Revocation of Accreditation
- 4. Student-Participants privacy in relation to The Scholarships 4 Us® Program is to remain confidential unless otherwise expressed by a Parent, Legal Guardian, or Authorized Representative
- 5. All Accredited Event funds must be submitted using the Payment Processing Solution

SECTION 7: INCIDENT REPORTING

Scholarships 4 Us® is not affiliated with Safesport and Accredited Hosts are not required through our organization to register as we are not a National Governing Body of the U.S. Olympic and Paralympic Movement. If you or someone you know has questions we encourage you to visit their website and contact them directly.

Youth organizations are required to provide Articles of Corporation/ Organization, General Liability Insurance, and sign the Terms and Conditions of Use in order to register with Scholarships 4 Us[®]. SECTION 9: THE RULE OF AMATEURISM™



Amateurism has been a concept that is misunderstood and misinterpreted, and therefore caused more harm than good. In the near future, Scholarships 4 Us® may have absolute jurisdiction over Amateurism when The Program™ is recognized by the postsecondary educational institutions as the Legislative-Compliance enterprise for potential collegiate athletes and students. Every postsecondary educational institution that has a legally binding contract with a collegiate athletic association will have to collectively unite in adopting The Rule of Amateurism™ for the liberation of the Student-Athlete from authoritarianism.

Furthermore, collegiate Student-Athletes will have to unite in the understanding that they can no longer wait for their 'Financial Share' of the revenue for being a billion dollar asset to postsecondary educational institutions and the collegiate athletic associations. The 'value' of the Cost of Education and the 'value' of Room and Board that has been justified as a 'Fair Share,' inexchange for services, by the collegiate athletic associations has, since its inception, been breadcrumbs resulting in collegiate athletes being treated like a night walker that has been groomed to be grateful they have a place to sleep and food to eat while their owner relishes in the financial profits from their labor.

The comprehensive approach to forming a national understanding and enforceable practice of Amateurism is through Scholarships 4 Us®: The Rule of Amateurism™. Eligibility shall begin on a students' 12th birthday and expire May 31st their senior year of high school. The idea is that once a student graduates high school they will have fulfilled their Amateurism and will then have the choice to request their Accumulated Prize Funds as Prize Money without affecting their eligibility to participate in collegiate athletics. Scholarships 4 Us® will implement and have jurisdiction over The Rule of Amateurism™ according to the Eligibility Criterion found in Section 10 of The Scholarships 4 Us® Program.





SECTION 10: ELIGIBILITY CRITERION

A Student is eligible to enroll and maintain enrollment in The Scholarships 4 Us® Program only if the following Eligibility Criterion is met:

- Actively enrolled in a U.S. Charter, Home, Public or Private Educational Institution*
- Be of age within the Eligibility Time Period

- Sign and agree to the 'Student-Participant Rights and Responsibilities'

Spring: March 1st - May 31st


