-The Accredited Hosts Logo is for recognition of a registered youth organization and is required to be used in all their publications.

## scholarships fus ${ }^{\circledR}$

An Accredited Event is a recognized competition or tournament by Scholarships 4 Us ${ }^{\circledR}$. that offers prize funds through the usage of our Program and Platforms. The Scholarships 4 Us Program ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ accredits events and the hosts that manage them to provide a national standardized competitions and tournaments for Student-Participants. All The Scholarships 4 Us Program's ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Accredited Events are designed by Accredited Hosts or Scholarships 4 Us. Once an event has been accredited using the 'Accreditation Criterion' it is uploaded to our website underneath the corresponding category: The Arts, Esports or Sports.

There are three levels of events: local, regional, and national. All regional and national events will use the Scholarships $4 \mathrm{Us}{ }^{\circledR}$. principles which includes purchasing tickets online on our Upcoming Events page. In local events it is up to the discretion of the Accredited Hosts on how to accept their Lineage Payments, but the Expense, Savings Contribution, and Prize Funds will be sent directly to Scholarships 4 Us ${ }^{\circledR}$ using the S4Us.portal ${ }^{\mid T M}$. Accredited Hosts are required to adhere to the general principles for all their Accredited Events and submit the 'Close An Event' form upon completion.
$>$ Scholarships 4 Us ${ }^{\circledR}$ uses the Wix.com platform at www.Scholarships4Us.com for event management and ticket sales
> Student-Participants log-in their membership account and use their Enrollment ID to purchase an individual ticket at www.Scholarships4Us.com/upcomingevents
> The 'Upcoming Events' page is exclusive for Student-Participants and Accredited Hosts
> Tickets can either be printed out or the QR Code can be scanned at check-in
> Regional and National Accredited Hosts have permission as a member to be a 'Check-In Assistant' for events using the Wix 'Owner App' (App Store or Google Play)

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## General

i. All events are required to have 25 entrants
ii. A team event must consist of 25 teams with the same number of participants on each
iii. Max participants per team is 25
iv. Max participants per event is 625
v. Events operate Thursday-Sunday
vi. There shall be no events from July $24^{\text {th }}$ - July $31^{\text {st }}$ and December $17^{\text {th }}$ - January $7^{\text {th }}$
vii. Events must take at least 2 -Hours but no more than 72 -Hours to complete and performed in the presence of an Accredited Hosts

viii. An event must be submitted 1-Week in advance using the 'Create An Event' template and emailed in .xlsx format to Events @Scholarships4Us.com with the Subject: Create An Event. Submission day is every Tuesday between 9am -12pm EST.
ix. An Event Cancellation must be submitted 48-Hours prior to the start date and emailed to Events @Scholarships4Us.com with the Subject: Cancel An Event
x. All events must be closed using the 'Close An Event' template and emailed in in .xlsx format to Accounts @Scholarships4Us.com with the template Subject: Close An Event (2.3.24@11am) every Monday between 9am - 12pm EST.
xi. Both event templates will be uploaded to the corresponding portal
xii. 'Lineage Payments'(see pg.10) take up to 7 business days to process and are sent every Wednesday

xiii. Tickets go on sale 24-Hours prior to the start of an event and close 1 -Hour prior
xiv. Student-Participants must Log-In their membership account and use their Enrollment ID to purchase an individual ticket at www.Scholarships4Us.com/upcomingevents
xv. All ticket sales are FINAL and NON-REFUNDABLE
xvi. A Student-Participant that is unable to attend the event will only be credited their Savings Contribution (see pg.10)

## COMPETITION FORMAT

- THE COMPETITION CONSIISTS OF STUDENT-PARTICIPANTS PICKING A THEME FOR A THEATRICAL RE-ENACTMENT
- ONCE ATHEME IS CHOSEN A POOL OF 25 'COMMON' CHARACTERS WILL BE PICKED BY THE STUDENT-PARTICIPANTS THAT REPRESENT THE THEME
- ALL THE 25 CHARACTERS WILL BE PLACED INTO A UNIT AND EACH STUDENT-PARTICIPANT WILL 'PICK YOUR POISON'
- STUDENT-PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUIRED TO RE-ENACT A 2-3 MINUTE SCENE, THEATRICALLY, FROM THEIR CHARACTER THAT CAPTIVATE THE THEME
- STUDENT-PARTICIPANTS WILL BE GIVEN A PREDETERMINED TIME PERIOD TO PREPARE


## THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES WILL BE USED TO DETERMINE EACH PLACE

A 5-PERSON PANEL OF JUDGES WILL CONSIST OF PERSONNEL THAT HAVE NO ASSOCIATION WITH THE STUDENT-PARTICIPANTS AND WILL USE THE FOLLOWING POINT SYSTEM WITH THE TIME MANAGED ON A DISPLAY CLOCK:

## SKILLS CHALLENGE FORMAT

- THE COMPETTION CONSISTS OF A 3-POINT SKILLS CHALLENGE
- tIME IS MEASURED USING A SHOT CLOCK

1) STUDENT-PARTICIPANTS WILL HAVE 60 SECONDS TO SHOOT 5 BALLS FROM 5 DIFFERENT STATIONS FROM THE 3-POINT LINE
2) STUDENT-PARTICIPANTS MAY SHOOT FROM EITHER SIDE OF THE STATION
3) FOUR BALLS ON THE RACK WILL BE WORTH 1-POINT AND THE FIFTH COLORED BALL WILL BE WORTH 2-POINTS
4) STATION LOCATIONS WILL BE AS FOLLOWED:
a) TOP OF THE KEY
b) LEFT AND RIGHT WING
c) LEFT AND RIGHT BASELINE
5) EACH PARTICIPANT WILL RECEIVE 2-QUALIFYING ROUNDS
6) POINTS WILL BE A TOTAL OF BOTH ROUNDS COMBINED
7) TOP 5 PARTICIPANTS WILL ADVANCE TO THE FINAL ROUND WITH POINTS CARRYING OVER
8) IN THE CASE OFA TIE PARTICIPANTS WILL COMPLETE THE SKILLS CHALLENGE AGAIN
