Disclosure Statement

"Scholarships 4 Us has no affiliation with the USBC (United States Bowling Congress) or SMART (Scholarship Management Account Reporting for Tenpins) and a junior bowler's SMART Account. Scholarships 4 Us is NOT an NGB (National Governing Body) of The Olympic or Paralympic Movement and all jurisdiction is held by the USBC to qualify for and/or be eligible to patriciate in (JOG) Juniors of Gold events. All recognized achievements including honor scores and the associated accolades are managed and provided by USBC sanctioned events, NOT Scholarships 4 Us."

- 1. The Scholarships 4 Us® Program and Platforms are available for Bowling Centers only
- 2. Bowlers are permitted to participate in USBC events and their SMART Program
- 3. All Scholarships 4 Us® events are 'Accredited' (see www.scholarships4us.com/terminology)
- 4. All students must be enrolled prior to participating in an event
- 5. Events are for youth bowlers ONLY
- 6. Adults are forbidden to participant in any event
- 7. Accredited Events can either be a skills competition or tournament play
- 8. Tournament play must consist of a minimum 3 games
- 9. Scholarships 4 Us® does NOT support league play
- 10. URETHANE balls are prohibited from being used in an Accredited Event
- 11. String Bowling is prohibited from being used in an Accredited Event
- 12. All events are SCRATCH
- 13. There is no HANDICAP used in an Accredited Event
- 14. All events shall use the host bowling center's standard House Shot pattern
- 15. If a Student-Participant works for the host bowling center then they are NOT permitted to oil the lanes for the event
- 16. Modified House Shot patterns are NOT permitted in any event
- 17. All events shall use a one-shot roll off in the case of a tie with the higher seed going first
- 18. Sport Shot patterns are NOT permitted in any event
- 19. Resurfacing of a bowling ball is only permissible prior to the start of the competition or tournament
- 20. First time participants must provide their most recent 'High Average' house-shot-league recap sheet with at least 54 Games
- 21. Failure to provide the most recent 'High Average' house-shot-league recap sheet will result in EXPULSION from The ProgramTM
- 22. Averages are calculated in qualifying rounds during tournament play ONLY
- 23. An Accredited Hosts determined to have intentionally falsified input scores will have their Accreditation revoked
- 24. There are 6 divisions for Student-Participants to compete in:
 - Division A: <129
 - **Division B:** 130 149
 - **Division C:** 150 179
 - > Division D: 180 199
 - **Division E:** 200 219
 - Division F: 220+

- 25. A Student-Participant may only compete in their respected division in an event
- 26. Student-Participants shall participate in the division that their average is within at the start of an Accredited Event
- 27. An Accredited Hosts must use the National RatingsTM found in the S4Us.portalTM for every Accredited Event
- 28. A tournament must have the required 25 entrants in a division
- 29. A skills competition is NOT restricted to divisions
- 30. Doubles, Trios, Four or Five Student-Participant team events are permitted
- 31. Inter-Division (within same division) team events must have the same number of participants from that division on each team
- 32. Cross-Division (more than one division) team events must have the same number of participants from each division
- 33. Accredited Hosts may request amendments to the Governing Principles by submitting them to the appointed governing members
- 34. The Governing Principles may ONLY be amended according to FanastasiasEsteatesTM Operating Agreement.



*National RatingsTM

National RatingsTM for tournament play are determined by averaging the averages. Accredited Hosts are required to input the average for each individual event in the Close An Event from: Score Input Field.

Example:

- A Student-Participant series in three games of qualifying is 600 so 200 must be imputed
- In the next event, a Student-Participant series in three games of qualifying is 660 so 220 must be imputed
- The Student-Participants' National RatingTM will be 210
