Hosts Accredited[™]

The Accredited Hosts[™] logo is for recognition of a registered youth organization and is required to be used in all marketing material.

An Accredited Event[™] is a recognized competition or tournament by Scholarships 4 Us[®] that awards Prize Funds funded with Prize Money based on Place Finish through the usage of The Scholarships 4 Us[®] Program and platforms. Scholarships 4 Us[®] accredits events and the youth organizations that manage them. An Accredited Event[™] is designed by Scholarships 4 Us[®] or Accredited Hosts[™]. Once an event has been accredited using the 'Accreditation Criterion' it is uploaded to the Scholarships 4 Us[®] website underneath the corresponding category: The Arts, Sports, or Esports.

Scholarships 4 Us[®] defines The Arts as an event in which Place Finish is determined on a subjective basis. Boxing is recognized as an art for the reason that Place Finish is determined by the judges that score each round. A Sport is defined as a competition or tournament in which Place Finish is determined an objective basis. Basketball is a Sport for the reason that Place Finish is determined on the basis of score.

Every Accredited Event[™] will use the Scholarships 4 Us[®] General Principles expressed on page 4 of the Accredited Events Guide which may include purchasing tickets through the S4Us.portal[™] to Upcoming Events. It is up to the discretion of the Accredited Hosts[™] on how to accept their Lineage Fee, but the Expense Fee, Savings Contribution, and Prize Fund will be submitted directly to Scholarships 4 Us[®] through the S4Us.portal[™].









- i. The Cost of Entry into an Accredited Event[™] is either \$40, \$80, or \$160
- ii. All events are required to have either 5, 10, 15, 20, or 25 entrants
- iii. A team event must consist of the same number of participants on each team
- iv. Every event will use of one the Itemized Allocation of Prize Funds to determine the Prize Fund for Place Finish based on Cost of Entry and Number of Participants
- v. Max participants per team is 25
- vi. Max participants per event is 625
- vii. There shall be no events from July 24th July 31st and December 17th January 7th
- viii. Events should take at least 1-Hour but no more than 72-Hours to complete and performed in the presence of an Accredited Hosts[™]

Accredited Hosts

- ix. An event must be created no less than 1-Week in advance using the 'Create An Event' form in the S4Us.portal™
- x. An event cancellation must be submitted 48-Hours prior to the start date in the S4Us.portal
- xi. Events must be closed upon completion using the 'Close An Event' form in the S4Us.portal™

Student-Participants

- xii. Tickets go on sale 24-Hours prior to the start of an event and close 1-Hour prior
- xiii. Student-Participants must Login the S4Us.portal[™] and use their Enrollment ID to purchase a ticket
- xiv. Ticket sales will be the Cost of Entry less the Lineage Fee that will be paid directly to the Accredited Hosts™
- xv. All ticket sales are FINAL and NON-REFUNDABLE
- xvi. Only 1 ticket purchase in permitted per participant per event
- xvii. Taxation will be paid by the buyer according to national, state, and/or local applicable tax laws
- xviii. Any service fee is passed on to the buyer
- xix. A Student-Participant that is unable to attend the event will be credited their Savings Contribution







- ✓ Suitable for Ages 12+
- ✓ Provides creativity and authenticity with a distinct 'original' name
- ✓ Be applicable to function with up to 25 entrants
- ✓ An 'Objective' event must clearly define the measuring tool(s) used to determine each place finish (I.E.- time clock)
- A 'Subjective' event must clearly define how the 'judges' are chosen and their criteria for 'judging' to determine each Place Finish (I.E.- point scale). A judge must not have any interest in the event or relation to a Student-Participant
- ✓ If applicable, classifications must clearly be defined (I.E.- 17U)
- ✓ If applicable, divisions must clearly be defined (I.E.- Gold/Silver/Bronze)



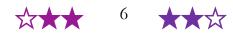

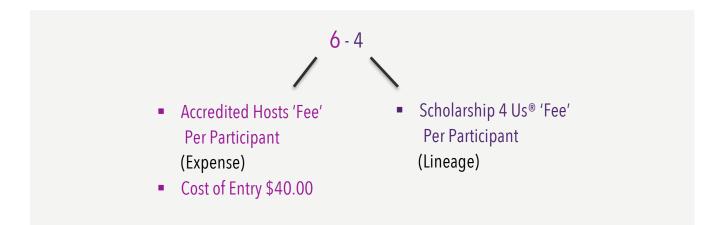

Scholarships 4 Us[®] has three Cost of Entry Platforms: 6-4, 12-8 and 24-16. An Accredited Hosts[™] will select the Cost of Entry platform when they create an event which will determine the ticket price. This uniformed system will ensure that The Scholarships 4 Us[®] Program maintains its national standard for Student-Participants Earning and Savings Account.



Cost of Entry Breakdown

GOLDEN GUIDELINES

25% - EXPENSE AND LINEAGE	(\$10.00)
25% - SAVINGS CONTRIBUTION	(\$10.00)
50% - PRIZE FUND	(\$20.00)

Top places accumulate Prize Funds based on the Cost of Entry and Number of Participants. The following percentage examples of the total money collected is based on \$40- Cost of Entry and 25 Student-Participants:

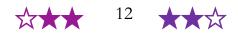

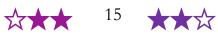






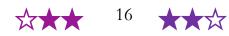

- 1. Tickets go on sale 24-Hours prior to the start of an event and close 1-Hour prior to the start time
- 2. All ticket sales are FINAL and NON-REFUNDABLE
- 3. Each ticket must be purchased individually using the Student-Participants Enrollment ID
- 4. Only 1-ticket purchase is allowed per participant per event
- 5. Taxation will be PAID BY THE BUYER according to national, state, and/or local applicable tax laws
- 6. Tickets will be emailed and may either be printed out or the QR Code can be scanned at check-in
- 7. A Student-Participant that is unable to attend the event will only be credited their Savings Contribution
